1. Be on your guard; stand firm in the faith; be courageous; be strong. - 1 Corinthians 16:13
2. The Lord is with me; I will not be afraid. What can man do to me? The Lord is with me; he is my helper. - Psalm 118:6-7
3. May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in him, so that you may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit. - Romans 15:13

10. But now, this is what the Lord says Ö Fear not, for I have redeemed you; I have summoned you by name; you are mine. - Isaiah 43:1

23. May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, so that by the power of the Holy Spirit you may abound in hope. - Romans 15:13

24. There is no fear in love. But perfect love drives out fear, because fear has to do with punishment. The one who fears is not made perfect in love. - 1 John 4:18

25. But as for me, I will look to the Lord; I will wait for the God of my salvation; my God will hear me. - Micah 7:7
